

Library Board Meeting
September 21, 2009

The Carroll Library Board of Trustees met in the Mayor's Conference Room of City Hall. Trustees present were Bogue, Brockelsby, Hartley, Louis, Neu, Schroeder, Setzler, Siemann and Director Fischbach. Trustee absent was Greteman.

Hartley called the meeting to order at 5:15. It was moved by Louis and seconded by Neu to approve the agenda. All voted aye. It was moved by Brockelsby and seconded by Setzler to approve the minutes of the August meeting. All voted aye. It was moved by Schroeder and seconded by Neu to approve the bills. All voted aye.

Director's Report: Toddler Story Time is still retaining high numbers. Banned Books week is September 26-October 3. Upcoming programs will be local patron Christy Ludwig speaking about knitting on October 8 and Danuta Hutchins with a program about President Hoover's food distribution in Europe after WWII on October 20. Movie night attendance stays steady and the book discussion group will meet on the second Tuesdays because of the programs being held on the third Tuesdays of the month. Knit for Charity event will be October 10. Summer Reading Program winners were rewarded their prizes courtesy of Carroll County State Bank, The Daily Times Herald and Signet Masonic Lodge #264. Upcoming staff training will be Lakeside Learning in Storm Lake on September 22 & 23 and the Iowa Library Association convention in Des Moines October 21-23. WILBOR audio books are now listed in the library catalog. The library has purchased new language learning software. Library information table placards will on display at several businesses in town. The Social Security provided three internet presentations for patrons in September.
