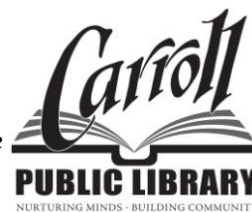

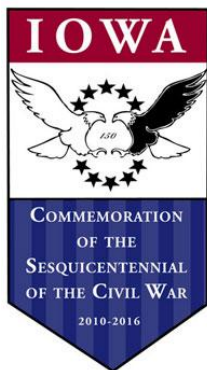

After six years of planning, it is time to move forward with building a new library.

- ◆◆ The Carroll Library Foundation has begun a capital campaign to raise money to support the building program.
- ◆◆ The Library Board of Trustees is working on educating the public about the project and what a larger library can offer citizens of Carroll and the surrounding area.
- ◆◆ The estimated cost for individual property owners and businesses will be determined in early summer. At that time Carroll city residents will have the opportunity to vote on the issue.
