Preliminary drawings for a new Carroll Public Library

The proposed project repurposes the current structure formerly known as the Heider Manufacturing building. It is located between Carroll and Main Streets on the north side of 3rd Street.

FEH architects will be presenting cost estimates to the Carroll City Council in November. The Carroll Library Foundation will then conduct a feasibility study to determine the amount of public interest in the project and potential donors. They anticipate making a full report to the City Council in February of 2011.
